ABOUT PORCELAIN

Porcelain tiles are extremely durable and provide a luxury aesthetic for your home. Porcelain is one of the most chosen materials for tiles throughout the home, though depending on the style and finish of your tiles, you need to take precise care of your tiles to keep them looking beautiful for longer.

HOW DO YOU CLEAN PORCELAIN TILES?

1. Whether they are on your walls or floor, you should first begin by removing any dust from your tiles. This can be done using a dry mop or a vacuum cleaner. You should ensure that you clean/wipe down all of the tiles, including the corners.
2. To focus on stains within one area, use warm water and a soft nylon brush to remove the localised stains, wiping them in a circular motion. Only use the brush in wet areas as this may cause harm to dry tiles when contacted directly with the brush.
3. To clean the full area, use a mop and a floor cleaner that is recommended for your style of tiles. If this solution is to be diluted, mix it with water before using the mop to distribute it across your tiles.
4. Finally, dry your tiles using a microfibre cloth or a cheesecloth.



HOW TO CLEAN DIFFERENT TYPES OF PORCELAIN TILES

Bathroom tiles

You should regularly clean your bathroom tiles using an appropriate cleaning solution. Bathroom tiles, with soap residue often collected, will need regular cleaning. To clean the tiles, mix the cleaning solution with water and spread onto the tiles using a mop or sponge. Once cleaned, dry with a cloth or dry mop.

Textured porcelain tiles

Due to the textured surface, these tiles will require more care and maintenance than smooth tiles, as the textured material can collect more dust. To avoid high levels of dust, you should clean your textured tiles more regularly. To clean the tiles, mix the cleaning solution with water and spread it onto the tiles using a mop or sponge. Once cleaned, dry with a cloth or dry mop.

Anti-slip porcelain tiles

Due to their anti-slip properties, these tiles can be more difficult to clean than average tiles. This is due to the fact that they can collect more dirt, which is why regular cleaning is required to maintain the highest standards.

HOW DO YOU REMOVE STAINS FROM PORCELAIN TILES?

For stubborn stains, this may require more care to ensure that the stain is fully treated and removed. Stubborn stains may include pen, make-up, grease, dirt, or blood. Each type of stain will need to be treated carefully.
